## **AND OUR RETREAT FACILITIES**

**We hope your stay is pleasant. There are some rules that we ask you to follow**

1. Please, have limited food and drink in the bedrooms.
2. Do not move furniture, pictures, etc. from room to room.
3. NO SMOKING is allowed in any of the buildings.
4. NO PETS are allowed inside the camp facilities. Animals must be outside and on a leash at all times.
5. No alcoholic beverages, drugs, firearms, knives, fireworks, ATV's etc. allowed on camp property.
6. Help us to conserve water, don't leave faucets dripping.
7. Remember to turn lights off when not in your room or cottage.
8. Recommended check out time is 11:00 am, when another group is scheduled to move in on the same day. Please talk with Aldersgate Camp staff if these times do not work with your retreat schedule. Recommended check in time is 3:00 pm.

### **ON LAST DAY:**

9. Please clean up your own room. Remove linens from the beds: vacuum floor and empty trash cans.
10. In bathrooms: clean up shower, wipe up any water that might be on the floor and pick up all the trash from the floors. Don't worry about cleaning the commodes.

Your help in cleaning will help us to keep costs for retreats down.

## **I. What Aldersgate Expects of YOU**

- Retreat Leader is ultimately responsible for conduct/action of all participants.
- When coming to the Lodge, all vehicles should be parked in the gravel parking lot by the office, unless someone needs to use the handicapped ramp.
- The Lodge kitchen is off limits to all, unless invited in or for prearranged snacks.
- Meals are at the following times, unless other arrangements are made
  - Breakfast - 8:30 am; lunch – 12:00 pm; dinner – 6:00 pm
  - Everyone present is billed for their meal whether they eat or not.
  - Some help setting up may be needed for large groups prior to meals, if you would like to help, please let us know.
  - Everyone must bus their own tray and properly dispose of items.
  - Groups are responsible for cleanup of the Lodge dining hall after each meal by wiping tables that you used and sweeping the floor.
  - Please, do not waste food.
- Lights and water should be turned off when not in use.
- Room rules and cleanup expectations are included in this book.
- Christ-like conduct is always expected and appreciated.

**DIRECTIONS TO MARCUM-WALLACE MEMORIAL HOSPITAL:**

From Aldersgate Camp Rd. turn onto 975

At the stop sign at the end of 975, turn right onto 1182

At the stop sign at the end of 1182(this is almost immediate), Turn left onto 52 east.

go 1.3 miles. Turn right onto 1571

Follow 1571 for 5.5 miles along river, across the one lane bridge and under the railroad underpass to the stop sign and flashing red light at 52.

Go straight through intersection and proceed onto 52.

Follow 52 about 2 miles to through Irvine / Ravenna to stop light beside the courthouse

Turn right on HWY 89, follow for 1 mile to second stoplight.

Turn left at stop light onto Carhartt Ave.

Take first right up the hill to Marcum-Wallace Memorial Hospital

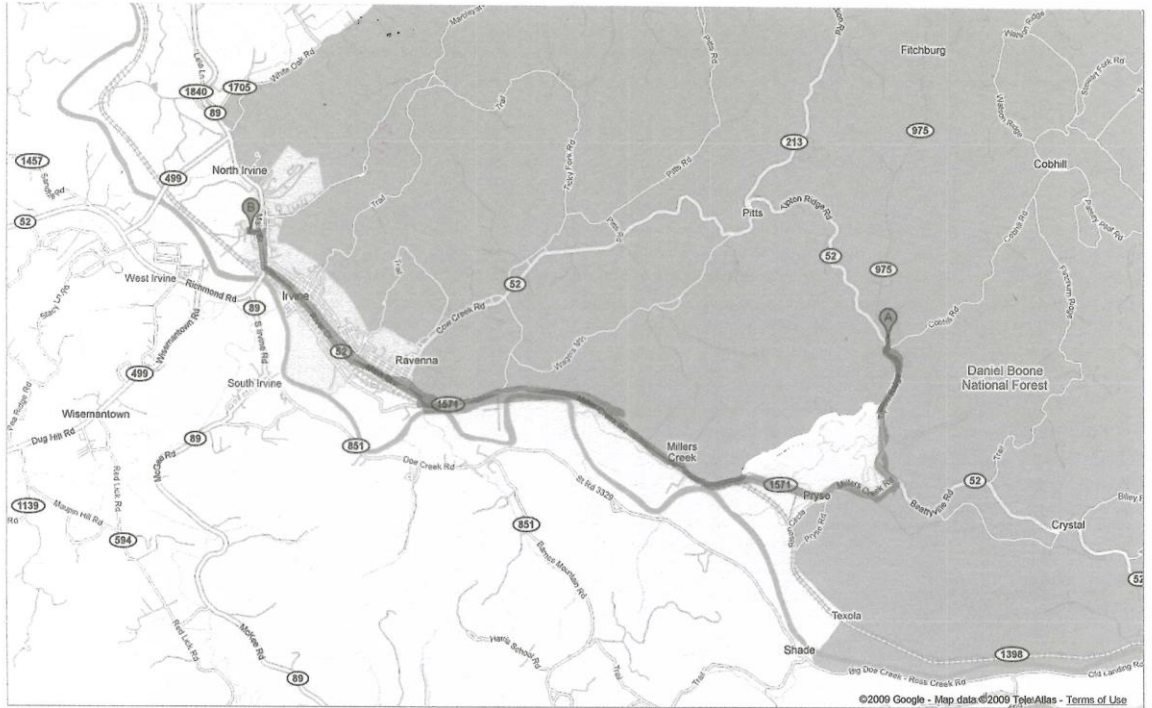
